Less stress with PCS! As soon as you receive PCS orders, register using the calendar at: mccs-sc.com. Contact the IR&R Office for more information. Spouses are welcome and encouraged to attend.

This is a mandatory workshop for all personnel who receive PCS orders per MCO 1754.10B.

SPONSORSHIP PROGRAM
